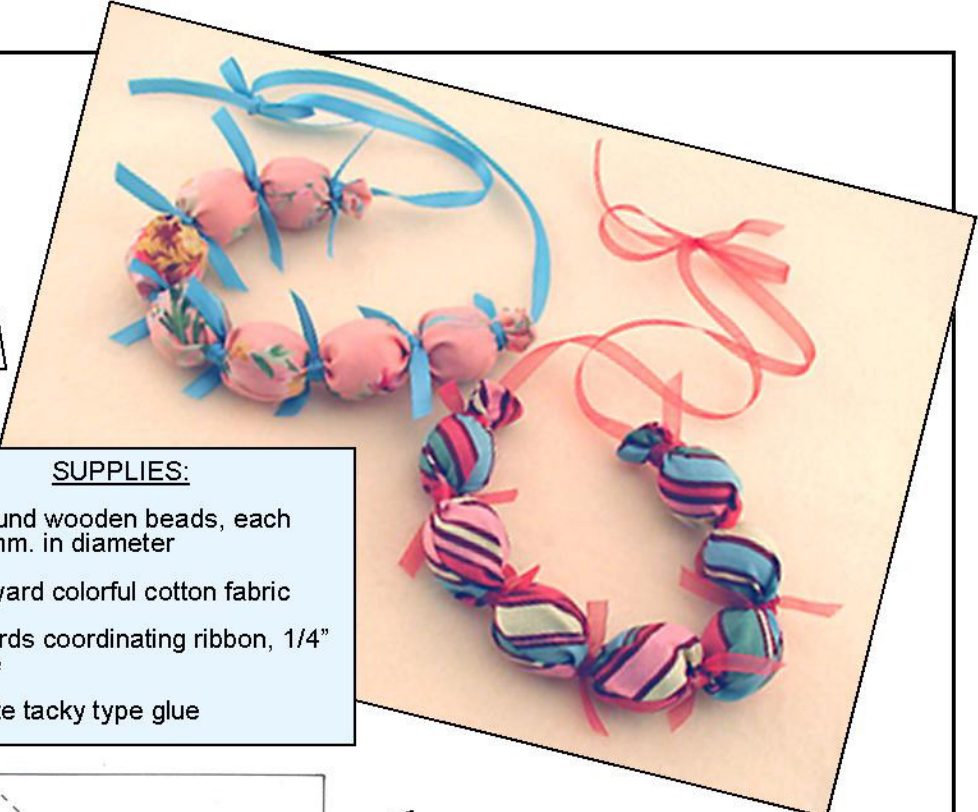


COVERED BEAD NECKLACE

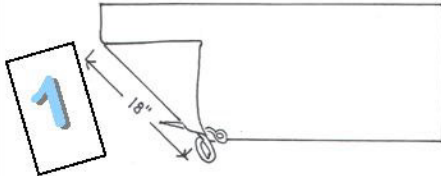


TOOLS:

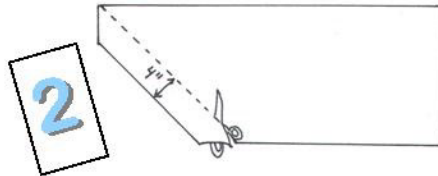
- Sewing machine
- Sharp fabric scissors
- Tape measure
- Large safety pin

SUPPLIES:

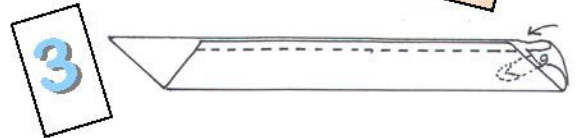
- 7 round wooden beads, each 25 mm. in diameter
- 1/2 yard colorful cotton fabric
- 3 yards coordinating ribbon, 1/4" wide
- White tacky type glue



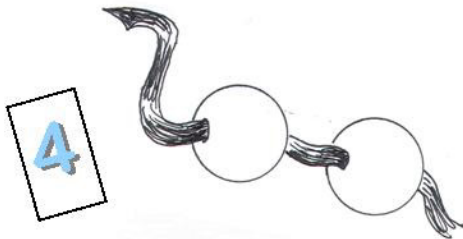
1 Fold fabric corner diagonally with 18" folded edge. Cut along the fold.



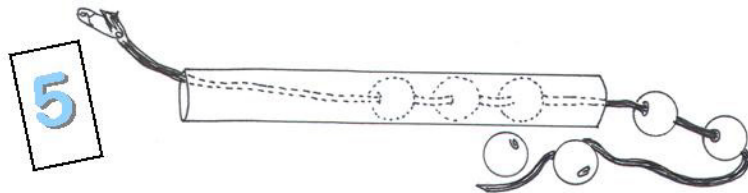
2 From the diagonal edge, measure and cut a strip 4" wide.



3 Fold strip in half lengthwise and stitch using 3/8" seam allowance. Attach safety pin to one end and thread through the middle to turn right side out. Trim ends evenly.



4 Cut 8 pieces of ribbon each 6" long and set aside. String the remaining ribbon through each bead hole.

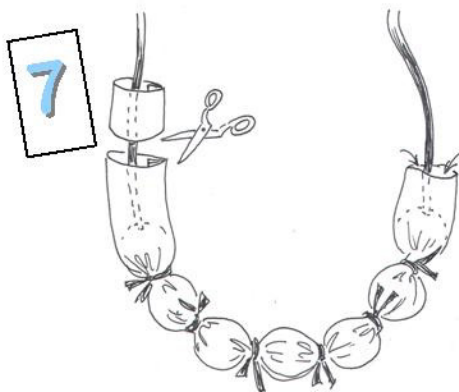


5 Attach the safety pin to the end of the long ribbon. Insert beaded ribbon through the middle of the fabric tube.



6 Center the beads in the tube. Pinch fabric together between each bead and tie tightly with the short pieces of ribbon.

7 Before tying off the beads at each end, trim the fabric ends 2 1/2" from the last tie-off. Be careful not to cut the ribbon inside. At each end, fold 3/4" of fabric to the inside.



8 Pinch fabric at each end and tie off. Glue inside the tube ends at the center ribbon. Tie the necklace around your neck and trim short and long ribbon ends as desired.
